The 2022 Miss Andouille Pageant will be held on Saturday, October 1, 2022, at St. Peter's Catholic School, 188 West 7th Street, Reserve, LA 70084. The pageant will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m. The theme this year is "If the Shoe Fits".

Eligibility

Contestants must be single, childless, and between the ages of 17-23 on the date of the pageant. Contestants must not have ever been married or arrested and ***must reside in the River Parishes.***

Interview

All contestants will be required to have an interview with the judges. Each interview will last approximately 8 minutes and will begin at 11:00 a.m. Please arrive no later than 10:45 a.m. The interviews will be located at The Government Complex Building, 1811 West Airline Hwy, LaPlace, LA 70068. **Only contestants are allowed to be present at interviews. Parents will be allowed to wait for the contestants in the Council Chambers.**

On-Stage

All contestants will be presented in an opening number where contestants will give a brief introduction at the opening of the pageant, stating their name and contestant number. The evening gown portion will consist of an on-stage question and overall presentation of each contestant.

Contestants will be asked an impromptu question on stage.

Rehearsal

In an effort to accommodate everyone's schedules there will be six (6) rehearsals. These rehearsals will be held on Monday, September 12th from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 14th from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Monday, September 19th from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 21st from 6:00pm-8:00 p.m., Monday, September 26th from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and again September 29th from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at St. Peter's Catholic Church, 188 W 7th Street, Reserve, LA 70084. It is recommended that you attend all practices, if possible, but mandatory that you attend September 29th. Opening number dance entertainment will be taught for the pageant. A full production run through will take place beginning at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 29th.

Items to Rehearse

Contestants should bring the shoes they plan to wear for the actual contest to rehearsal.

Each Contestant will practice the following:

Introduction

- Walk from rear center stage to microphone & state name, contest #.
- Walk to designated area on stage (to be determined) & contestants will lineup in numerical order.
- Exit stage. Emcee will announce when to the leave stage.

Evening Gown

- Enter from rear center of stage & walk to the designated area layout.
- Exit stage.
- Contestants will line-up in numerical order and form a line across stage (*Emcee will announce*).
- Emcee will ask contestants to turn and face back of stage and will ask contestants to turn and face audience.
- Exit stage (*Emcee will announce*).
- *TBD: On Stage Question will not be practiced in advance of the pageant*

Line up for Award Ceremony

- Contestants will be asked to return to the stage and line up in numerical order for announcement of award winners.

IF YOU WIN ANY AWARD

Order of what a contestant should do if they receive an award:

- a) Step forward & accept award. Walk to stage left and await announcements of other winners.
- b) **If you are selected Queen**, step forward accept award & wait for the banner/crown/train/mantle & flowers to be given to you and walk the stage as rehearsed.
- c) **Teen Queen will not receive a train and mantle.**

AFTER AWARDS ARE GIVEN

- a) If you win an award, please wait on stage for pictures to be taken for pageant and news media.
- b) **NO ONE IS ALLOWED ON STAGE UNTIL OFFICIAL PICTURES ARE TAKEN.**
- c) Queen and Contestant Reception to follow at Petra's Restaurant & Lounge, 1036 W Airline Hwy, LaPlace, LA 70068.
